Some states require that business schools in certain colleges and universities seek certification from one of the business specific accreditation agencies. This accreditation validates that the courses you take from accredited online universities meets certain standards. It also ensures you that the instructors are well qualified in their fields to provide you with the skills and knowledge needed to graduate and find a job. Each state has different rules regarding accreditation. If you are not sure, check with your state to find out more.

While not every online degree program requires accreditation, finding a program that does means that your school is interested in being the best. Do you enjoy your work as a pharmacist? Would you benefit by taking additional educational classes in the field? You could complete an advanced degree in pharmacy completely online. The program can be found at accredited universities and are taught with the same outcomes required of students who attend classes on-campus. - Clinical Nutrition

Even before earning your degree in nutrition online, you can begin setting up fitness and nutrition routines, and consult with clients and other nutritionists on their programs. The biggest benefit is that it could increase your employability since many health care facilities hire the majority of people in this field.

The average annual income was around \$100,000 with an average lifetime earning potential of \$4.4 million. This is especially significant when you compare it to the average lifetime earning potential of someone with only a high school diploma which is \$1.2 million. These salary comparisons help to point out that improving yourself by earning a college degree can pay off in the long run.

Salaries For Educators

A professor salary or a teacher salary may not be among the highest nationally, but they do vary based on such things as field of study and geographic location. A teacher or professor in a larger city may make a higher salary than someone in a rural setting. In addition, university professors in certain fields like business or computers may be able to get a higher salary than someone in a field that is less in demand like English or history. There are number of factors that can influence the average salary that someone can earn in these fields. If you are interested in a career in teaching, check with the school or university to find out about the salary scale they use.

Salaries For Engineers

You will find engineers among the highest paid in the U.S. This includes many of the different specializations in the field like mechanical, civil, industrial, chemical and environmental. An engineering salary has a good entry level salary which varies by location but overall continues to climb and stay among the highest paid professions. For those just starting out in the industry, you can expect to make the following:

- Aerospace Engineer: \$48,000-\$58,000
- Civil Engineer: \$46,000-\$55,000
- Industrial Engineer: \$46,000-\$59,000
- Electrical Engineer: \$50,000-\$60,000
- Environmental Engineer: \$45,000-\$55,000
- Mechanical Engineer: \$49,000-\$50,000

The higher salaries earned in this field are often based on educational background where a master's degree in the field can qualify you to earn more than someone with a bachelor's degree only.

Salaries In The Legal Field Among The Highest

A paralegal salary might not make a salary comparable to a lawyer's salary, but considering the educational level attained by each they are both pretty good. According to America's Career InfoNet, employment for Paralegals is growing at the same time the median salary in the field is among the highest paying jobs. Similarly, lawyers can be found among the highest paying jobs with high employment growth.

What Are The Highest Paying Jobs?

The highest paying jobs according to America's Career InfoNet are mostly in the medical field. If you look at those jobs that require only an associate's degree, that changes slightly. In fact, these jobs show that highest median income include nuclear technicians, dental hygienists, and computer specialists among others.
